



Methodology

QC125 commissioned a survey of City of Montreal electors.

Mainstreet surveyed a stratified random sample of 500 City of Montréal residents from September 20-22, 2017 through live interviews. Residents were screened for voting eligibility. Landline and cell lines were included. Responses were weighted using demographic information to targets based on the 2016 census.

The margin of error for survey results is \pm 4.38 percentage points, 19 times out of 20. The margin of error is greater for sub samples.

Numbers may not add up to 100 due to rounding.
