

#### Methodology





An online survey.



1512 Canadians, 18+ (those who selected "I don't know" are excluded from the results for comparative purposes).



Completed between July 7th and July 10<sup>th</sup>, 2023, using Leger's online panel.



No margin of error can be associated with a non-probability sample (i.e. a web panel in this case).

For comparative purposes, though, a probability sample of 1512 respondents would have a margin of error of ±2.5%, 19 times out of 20.

#### Leger's online panel
